 - Receive standardized test scores of either an SAT Total Score of 1200 and above OR an ACT Composite Score of 26 or above
 - Demonstrate unmet financial need (up to \$96,000 family income)

- ❖ Deadline: July 31st
- Criteria:
 - Current senior and 18 years of age by date of application to the scholarship program
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0
 - Minimum of 1000 on SAT or 21 on ACT
 - Acceptance at a 4-year college/university GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4-point scale for high school and/or college
 - Financial need as demonstrated by the gross annual household income ceiling up to
 - \$70,000 for a family of four or less, and \$80,000 for a family of five or more or \$35,000 (if considered independent)
 - Availability to work at least two 90-day summer tours prior to graduation and willingness to work at CIA full time after graduation
